

Home Euthanasia with Creature Comfort Mobile Vet



Thank you for trusting Creature Comfort Mobile Vet with your pet's final journey. When the appointment day arrives, Dr. Su-en will come promptly to your home and take time to ensure everyone feels settled.

There is no need to prepare anything specific. Your pet may rest wherever they feel most comfortable — on the couch, in their bed, on your lap, or even in the garden. The appointment is never rushed, and we move at a pace that prioritises comfort and calm.

Step 1: Gentle sedation



A small injection is given under the skin to help your pet become sleepy and relaxed. Most pets fall asleep within 5–10 minutes, while some larger dogs may take 15–20 minutes. We ask that you gently hold your pet for this quick and usually painless injection.

As the sedation takes effect, your pet will gently lie down, close their eyes, and may snore softly or let their tongue relax as they drift into a deep, peaceful sleep. While they sedate, you may offer pats, cuddles, or their favourite snacks, and sit quietly together.

Step 2: IV Cannula Placement



Once your pet is fully asleep and relaxed, an IV cannula is placed.

This is only done when your pet is completely calm and unaware of touch or clippers, ensuring they remain comfortable throughout.

Step 3: The Final Injection



After the cannula is in place, the final injection is given. Dr. Su-en will guide you through this process and explain what to expect so that you feel prepared.

You may continue to hold, cuddle, or pat your pet during this time. The process is smooth and gentle, and there are usually no sudden movements. As your pet passes peacefully, it is natural for their body to relax fully, and they may void as a sign of complete relaxation.

Aftercare



If cremation is chosen, Dr. Su-en will carefully take your pet with her on the day and arrange the cremation. For larger dogs, assistance may be needed to carry them using a stretcher, which can be done with the help of one other person.

Once your pet's ashes are ready, Dr. Su-en will return them to your home free of charge, typically within 2-4 weeks.
